

RDCK REGIONAL BOARD MEETING, MAY 23, 1998

RESOLUTION NO. 456/98

The guidelines for offering comments and recommendations on ALR applications as established by Board Resolution No. 402/96 be replaced with the following guidelines for processing ALR applications:

It be the *policy* of the Board that:

- (1) All applications for ALR inclusion and/or exclusion be forwarded to the Agricultural Land Commission with a completed Schedule 2 and information package. If applicable, any planning amendment applications will be considered once a resolution from the Agricultural Land Commission has been received.
- (2) (i) On lands subject to an official community plan, rural land use bylaw or zoning bylaw:
 - (a) Applications shall be forwarded to the ALC without review for subdivisions or non-farm uses that conform to planning bylaws with a completed Schedule 2 and information package;
 - (b) Applications shall not be forwarded to the ALC for subdivisions or non-farm uses that do not conform to planning bylaws and, if requested, staff shall discuss with the applicant the process for bylaw amendment;
- (ii) When requested by the Area Director, on lands not subject to an official community plan, rural land use bylaw or zoning bylaw, the Board shall review and make comments or recommendations on ALR subdivision and non-farm use applications.
