At the end of the meeting, the public were able to assign the stars as they felt to the issues that were most important to them. The issues and their relative importance were split into three groupings as follows:

- No planning process should be conducted;
- Issues that can be dealt with to some extent through a planning process; and
- Those issues that primarily cannot be dealt with through an Official Community Plan (OCP) pursuant to the *Local Government Act*.
